Summer Reading Program 2010

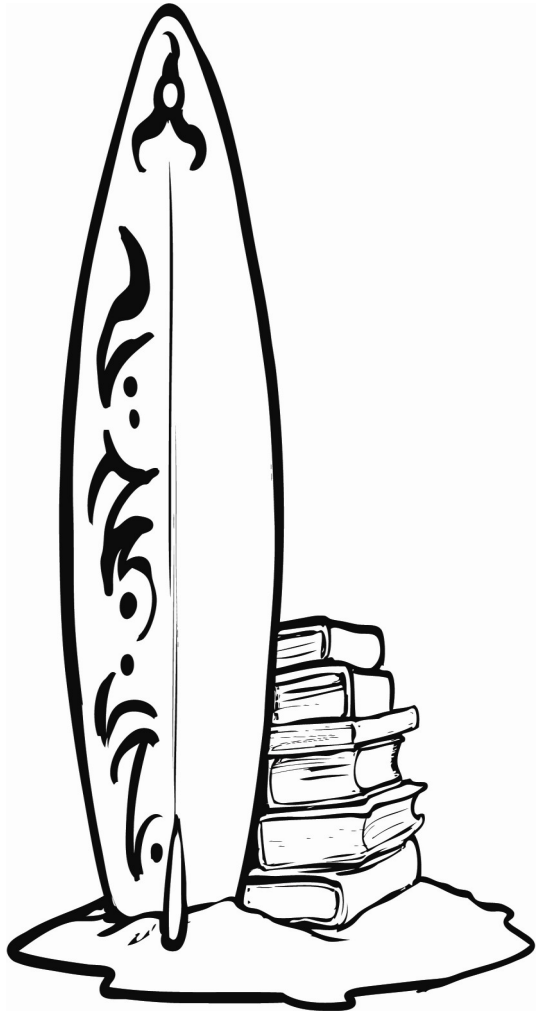
When: Registration starts June 21 and the program runs through July 30

Who can participate? Any child or teen in pre-school through 12th grade (there is also a Summer Reading Program offered for adults as well).

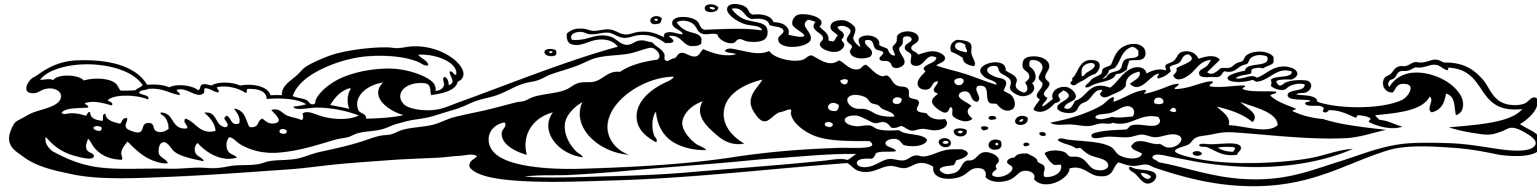
Why should I read this summer? It will help keep your brain in shape for when you head back to school in the fall! Plus, you can earn some awesome prizes for reading throughout the summer!
