- A. In order to remain open on holidays, the county would pay staff time and a half.
- B. Community Foundation of the NRV Library Endowment: the library received \$680 in April, 2025 which was added to donations to use as needed.
- C. Pulaski Library Blood Drive will take pace on May 29, 2025 at the Pulaski Library.
- D. Patron Complement was shared with the Board concerning the pleasure a patron found in library programming that brought five generations of women together "laughing and chatting" during a craft project.
- E. Imagination Library: Kristine reported the current membership for DPIL. The State has approved continued 50% match for books and mailing for monthly invoices.
- F. Friends of the Library will donate money to the PC Schools summer book bus and to Imagination Library.
- G. Reception in Honor of *Sweet Senior Pups* by Kama Einhorn. Cindy Eller presented copies of the book for the libraries and Board of Trustees.
- VI. Adjournment: Copies of the Summer Reading Challenge brochure were distributed. Lynne moved to adjourn, seconded by Kathy and approved.
